ELIGIBILITY RULES:

1. Must be a graduating high school senior planning to attend an accredited post secondary learning institution.
2. Is currently a certified member of the La Crosse River Valley USBC and is actively bowling in a USBC certified youth league within the boundaries of the La Crosse River Valley USBC.
3. Applicant must be in good standing in the USBC, WIAA, and/or the MNSHL if involved in high school activities.
4. Application and all related information must be postmarked by April 1st of the graduating year.
5. All information should be sent in **one envelope** to the office of the La Crosse River Valley USBC at the address below.

APPLICATION PROCEDURE:

1. Form #1: **PERSONAL INFORMATION**. Filled out and signed by the applicant.
2. Form #2: **HIGH SCHOOL DATA**. Filled out by the applicant and signed by a school official verifying scholastic information.
3. Form #3: **BOWLING INFORMATION**. Filled out by the applicant and signed by a bowling coach verifying bowling information.
4. Essay: A **typed** essay of at least 200 to 300 words addressing the question: **“How has bowling positively influenced my life?”**
