#### **ELIGIBILTY RULES:**

- 1. Must be a graduating high school senior planning to attend an accredited post secondary learning institution.
- 2. Is currently a certified member of the La Crosse River Valley USBC and is actively bowling in a USBC certified youth league within the boundaries of the La Crosse River Valley USBC.
- 3. Applicant must be in good standing in the USBC, WIAA, and/or the MNSHL if involved in high school activities.
- 4. Application and all related information must be postmarked by April 1<sup>st</sup> of the graduating year.
- 5. All information should be sent in **one envelope** to the office of the La Crosse River Valley USBC at the address below.

#### **APPLICATION PROCEDURE:**

Applications are available from association directors, officers, and coaches. All forms may be copied.

- 1. Form #1: **PERSONAL INFORMATION**. Filled out and signed by the applicant.
- 2. Form #2: **HIGH SCHOOL DATA**. Filled out by the applicant and signed by a school official verifying scholastic information.
- 3. Form #3: **BOWLING INFORMATION**. Filled out by the applicant and signed by a bowling coach verifying bowling information.
- 4. Essay: A **typed** essay of at least 200 to 300 words addressing the question: **"How has bowling positively influenced my life?"**
